



# Welcome to AwesomeStories Summer Reading Program!




Use the provided codes and your email address to Login to AwesomeStories.


Once you have logged in to one of the Summer Reading Story Series you will see your student dashboard such as the one below.




The assignment tab is where you will find all of the Summer Reading work for this Story Series. Click on the tab to open up the list of assignments.








**TASK DESCRIPTION**
