President John F. Kennedy to McGeorge Bundy October 16, 1962

For the first time in weeks, clouds over <u>Cuba</u> gave way to clear skies. It was October 14, 1962.

Fifteen days before - under the gray skies of emotional turmoil - <u>President Kennedy had ordered</u> federal law enforcement personnel to the campus of Ole Miss. Their job was to make sure that <u>James Meredith</u> was allowed to enroll as the University's first African-American student. Meanwhile ... Mississippi state troopers had gathered on the same campus to prevent that very enrollment.


Riots ensued, killing two people and wounding scores more.

The showdown, in Mississippi, was just a foretaste of how a bad siuation could worsen. What the President was about to learn - regarding events in Cuba - would trigger an international crisis.

Taking advantage of the clear skies - on that October day, in 1962 - <u>Major Richard Heyser</u> flew his <u>U-2</u> on a flight ("Mission 3101") over the Caribbean island. This CIA map depicts his route of travel.


