<u>Portuguese slave hunters</u> (called "<u>slavers</u>") illegally wrenched Sengbe and his fellow captives from their homes in February, 1839. It was an all-too-common occurrence, even after the British Parliament outlawed the slave trade in 1807.

Using inhuman <u>devices</u> to control their victims, slavers violated all existing treaties and laws. The practice continued due to demand for cheap labor in the "New World."

During the <u>difficult journey</u> from Africa to <u>Cuba</u> - called "The Middle Passage" - many of the captured people died. Fifty-three Africans (of Mandingo, Gbandi, Vai, Lorma, Kissi and Mendi heritage) were transferred to *La Amistad*, a ship chartered by two Spaniards who had "purchased" the captives at <u>auction</u> in Havana.

Four children were among the Amistad Africans.


