

Vasily Zaitsev, known as Vasha to family and friends, grew up in the foothills of the <u>Ural Mountains</u>. His grandfather taught him to hunt in the taiga, the nearby Siberian forest.

When he became a man, Zaitsev remembered what his grandfather had taught him:

The man of the forest is without fear.

Soviet commanders also remembered what they had learned two years before: Heavy casualties could be inflicted by one trained sniper.

On the receiving end of such an experience, the Red Army lost at least 500 men when <u>Simo Hayha</u>, a Finnish farmer, fought Russian invaders during the Winter War of 1939/40. Thereafter, the Soviet command placed heavy emphasis on the use of snipers. <u>Vasily</u>, with his natural ability, was perfect for the job.

Used to waiting hours to take his best shot in the taiga, Vasha was patient. He had a famous saying:

Await the right moment for one, and only one, well-aimed shot.

Legend has it that for his 242 Stalingrad "kills," Vasily took only 243 shots.
