Most folks know about <u>Paul Revere</u>, the American Revolutionary War hero. He was the guy who <u>rode</u> through the Massachusetts countryside on April 18, 1775 <u>warning</u> residents that the British were coming. His <u>plan</u> was to hang a light -

one if by land two if by sea

- in the North Church <u>tower</u> in Boston. People remember him and not his companions, William Dawes and Samuel Prescott.

Because the British captured him, Revere never reached Concord that fateful night when the war began. Thanks to Henry <u>Wadsworth Longfellow</u>, though, American school children - for more than a hundred years - memorized the poem which made Revere famous.

But there is another, virtually unknown story that substantially diminished Paul Revere's standing as a soldier. He stood trial on charges of cowardice and insubordination in a military court martial.




Paul Revere's Ride


