The <u>Dead Sea</u> is the lowest <u>body of water</u> on the planet. It averages 1,000 feet deep. <u>Nothing grows</u> or lives in its <u>salty water</u>. Trying to swim in it, a <u>person bobs</u> like a cork. Trying to wade in it, a <u>person could slip on the salty glaze</u> that covers its shore. It is like <u>nowhere else</u> on earth.

Supplied by the Jordan River, plus other smaller streams and springs, the <u>Dead Sea</u> has <u>no exit point</u> and is <u>located</u> in Israel and Jordan. It is <u>near</u> the famous archeological sites of <u>Masada</u> and <u>Qumran</u>.

In 1947, while looking for a lost goat, young <u>Bedouins</u> found some ancient scrolls in the <u>caves of Qumran</u>. Unknown to those young shepherds, they had found the oldest-known surviving manuscripts of the Hebrew Scriptures. One thousand years older than any other surviving Scripture manuscripts, the Qumran scrolls were a magnificent find.

But ... why were they hidden in desolate caves near the Dead Sea?
